Schedule of Contributions and Charges 2025

Parents will be notified of any contributions and charges expected of them, at least two months before the start of the school year by publication in newsletter and school website.

Charges are costs for which payment is compulsory. All charges are to be paid in full by end Term 1, 2025. Compulsory charges apply to all courses in Years 11 and 12. There is no maximum charge for Year 11 and 12 courses.

The school will request full payment of charges for BEST and VASP courses prior to commencement of the course. These courses have a high cost component and participation in these courses is conditional on payment.

Contributions are requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by Year 7 to Year 10 students in the educational program. Payment of voluntary contributions allows students to take part in the educational activities covered by the contribution. The amount of voluntary contributions will not exceed \$235.

Voluntary Additional Requests include financial support for P&C, chaplain, library and Building Preservation & Heritage Fund.

Extra cost optional components are voluntary courses and activities. A student's participation in an extra cost optional component is conditional on payment of the costs of that component. Extra cost options include:

- optional courses in Years 7 to 10 which have a high cost associated with their provision (for example outdoor education, design and technology courses).
- optional activities in any course for which there is a high cost associated with their provision (for example excursions [including camps], visiting performers or displays).
- other optional school-based activities which address broad learning outcomes for which there is a high cost (for example school social events, such as graduation dinners or school balls, or excursions).

Vocational Education and Training (VET) fee-for-service course is a qualification, including training and assessment, delivered or auspiced by an external Registered Training Organisation (RTO), usually at significant per student cost.

50% deposit is required for certificate courses, payable by 29 November 2024, with the balance due by 29 January 2025. The school subsidises \$1000 course fee on successful completion of any prior certificate course undertaken.

Personal items and other services costs are met by parents.

Type 1: Items for personal use:

- BYOD (bring your own device), calculator, stationery, hire of musical instruments

Type 2: Other personal items required for school:

- School bag, sports clothing, school uniform

Type 3: Other services provided by the school which are not required for educational program:

- School magazine, leavers jackets, school photographs

Secondary Assistance Scheme (SAS)

To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a valid Centrelink card (Health Care/Pensioner Concession) or Veterans' Affairs card that has the students listed.

The allowance consists of two components:

- \$300 Clothing Allowance paid directly to the parent/guardian or the school.
- \$235 Educational Program Allowance paid directly to the school.

Application is made by the parent/guardian for students enrolled in Years 7–12 studying a full time secondary course at a Western Australian public school. Application forms available on the school website. Applications close end of Term 1.
